

ARVHA, Association for Research on the City and Habitat, launched the tenth edition of the "**Prize for female architects**" in 2022, with the support of the Ile de France Region, the National Council of the Order of Architects, the Pavillon de l'Arsenal and the city of Paris. For the 2022 Prize, ARVHA also received support from BNP PARIBAS Real Estate, Ciments Calcia, Unibail Rodamco, and COGEDIM as well as from Batiactu, TEMA and the Architect's Journal

This prize aims to highlight the works and careers of female architects, so that young female architects can be inspired by the women who have come before them, and to encourage parity in a profession still largely dominated by men .

In 2021 the jury awarded four prizes and two special mentions:

- Female Architect of the year: Anne-Françoise JUMEAU
- Original Work : Sara Martin CAMARA
- Special mention for original work : Béatrice MOUTON
- Young Female Architect of the Year : Eléonore MORAND
- Special mention for Young Female Architect of the Year : Marion TRIBOLET
- International Prize : Farshid MOUSSAVI



In 2021, the competition was open from April 1 to September 15, presided by Catherine GUYOT, Secretary General of ARVHA and President of Women in Architecture France, and Sophie DENISSOF, Vice-President of the jury and winner of the 2020 special mention for original works. The jury met on October 31, 2021, to designate the winners of each prize. The award ceremony took place live on December 12, 2021, in front of more than 200 people, followed by a further 1,500 by livestream. All the members of the jury and the winners of each category were interviewed on video, describing their vision for the prize, and these videos were made available on the ARVHA channel, and on LinkedIn and Facebook.

In 2022, 350 applications were examined, with a total of **1270 projects** presented.

In 2022, four prizes were awarded, with two mentions :

- ● **Female Architect of the year**, awarded for her completed projects – 3 to 5 built works built; a special mention was also awarded
- ● **An Original Work** by a female architect, and a special mention
- ● **Young Female Architect of the year**, under 40, awarded for her built and unbuilt works: 3 to 5 projects
- ● **International Prize**: 3 to 5 built works

The jury was made up of representatives of the National Order of Architects, including Elizabeth GOSSART, Béatrice AUXENT (president of ARCHITECTUELLES Hauts-de-France), and the winners of the 2021 Prizes, Anne-Françoise Jumeau (winner female architect 2021), Eléonore MORAND (winner young female architect 2021); Marion TRIBOLET (Special mention for the Young female Architect 2021), Sara Martin CAMARA (winner of the 2021 original work), Beatrice MOUTON (special mention for the 2021 original work), Sophie BERTHELIER (Secretary General of the Academy of Architecture and winner of the 2017 female architect of the year), Farshid MOUSSAVI (winner of the 2021 international prize), Bridget Munro (Senior architect at RSHP London, Vice Chair of WIA UK, and vice-president of the 2022 jury), Anna RAMOS (Director of the Mies Van der Rohe foundation in Barcelona and responsible for the Lily REICH research grant), Rosalind TSANG (Director of the BDP New York studio and co-president of the WIA committee of the AIA NY) and Catherine GUYOT secretary general of the ARVHA, president of Women in Architecture France, and president of the 2022 Jury.

Young female architect 2022

The prize for young female architect of the year is awarded to **Cristina Vega IGLESIAS**, of **Burlat and Vega Architectes**.

A special mention is awarded to **Claire Garcia Barriet** of **OVERCODE**.

Prize for an original work :

The prize for an original work is awarded to **Julie DEGAND** for her *“multipurpose and cultural centre in Sodbury”*

International prize 2022:

The international prize 2022 is awarded to **Rozana Montiel** of **ROZANA MONTIEL ESTUDIO DE ARQUITECTURA** for her body of work

Female architect of the Year 2022:

The prize for the female architect of the year 2022 is awarded to **Christelle AVENIER** of **Avenier Corenjo** for her body of work.

A special mention is awarded to **Adeline RISPAL**, of **Ateliers Adeline Rispal** for her body of work.
